- Tuition announcement, School Advisory Council's Ramey Chupp See attached slides from Presentation
 - o according to market research performed by SAC Texas public school cost to educate one child is \$12,500 \$9,700 arlington ISD per child SMG cost \$ 7,500 per child
 - o registration fee \$375 before May 31 / \$400 per student after May 31 (increase of \$25 over prior year)
 - o school supplies basics included in registration fee. Lists will be published for the grade specific supplies and parents will have the option to purchase
 - o tuition increase for 2017-18 school year is appx 5%
 - SMG has been able to maintain and build enrollment, while most of the other area catholic schools have had
 declines.
 - Father Luke survey of parish was distributed and the last question asked parishioners how they would spend \$1mm of Church funds if it was available to them popular answers included Parking, Youth ministry, and the School. SMG has capacity for 450 students and we are not there. Tuition assistance programs are being discussed, and any ideas are welcome. Father Luke also mentioned that the School is a ministry of the Parish, and as a part of that ministry the Parish indirectly subsidizes the school with capital expenditures, maintenance staff, etc. SMG Church spends tens of thousands of dollars a year to support the School.
